Prepare for Shipment

- 1. Put your film in a ziplock bag.
- 2. Insert this form, payment, and film inside a small box or padded envelope.
- Address the box/envelope: Midwest Image Works 5107 N. Ogden Ave. Peoria Heights, IL 61616
- 4. Apply appropriate postage and drop in any U. S. mailbox.

Due to the nature of film development, all orders are final. Midwest Image Works cannot tell if a roll of film is going to be blank or damaged before the development process begins.

Film storage conditions play a large part in the quality of your scans and developed negatives. Rolls should be developed as soon as possible after exposure and should not be stored in areas of high humidity or heat over 80 degrees Fahrenheit.

Scan Details

Scanned photographs and negatives are uploaded for downloading, printing, sharing, or posting to social media.

- Standard: (1500 DPI / 4.5MB)
 Best for web posting, 4x6" & 5x7" prints.
- Enhanced: (3600 DPI / 18MB)
 Best for detailed editing, portfolios, archival, up to 11x14" prints.
- Ultra: (7200 DPI / 30MB+).
 Best for large format & fine art prints up to 16x20"

As a result, the film will likely be unable to be developed and may be irreparably damaged or rendered unusable. No refund will be issued in this case. It is your responsibility to ensure the correct processing option is selected when placing your order.
- **5. Refunds:** Due to the nature of film processing, we do not offer refunds for processed film, except in cases of clear lab error, such as film damage during processing.
